Joint Statement: Collective Bargaining

Topeka- The Kansas Association of School Boards, the Kansas National Education Association, the Kansas School Superintendents Association and United School Administrators of Kansas met today (December 17, 2014) and reaffirmed support for collective bargaining and the need to negotiate items of importance to the education profession. We support the right of local boards and associations to bargain beyond those items that are mandatorily negotiable by law.

We will continue to work collaboratively to identify more efficient and effective ways to manage the bargaining process.

As a result of our work over the past few months, we have a clearer understanding of each other's interests. The group plans to have a recommended position for our respective boards by January 22.
